## Experiencing COVID-like Symptoms?

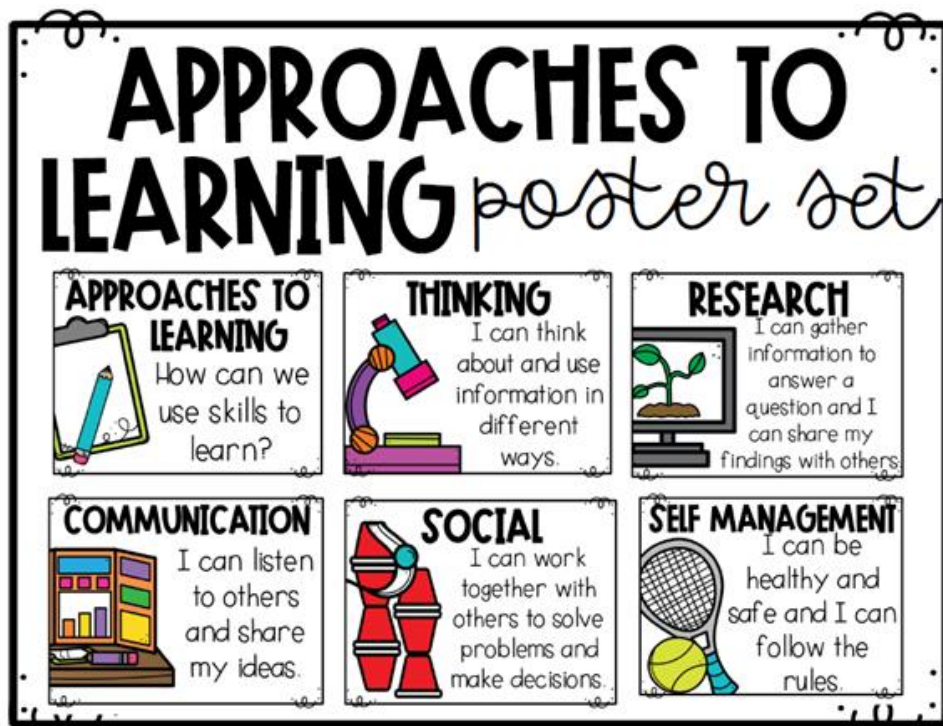
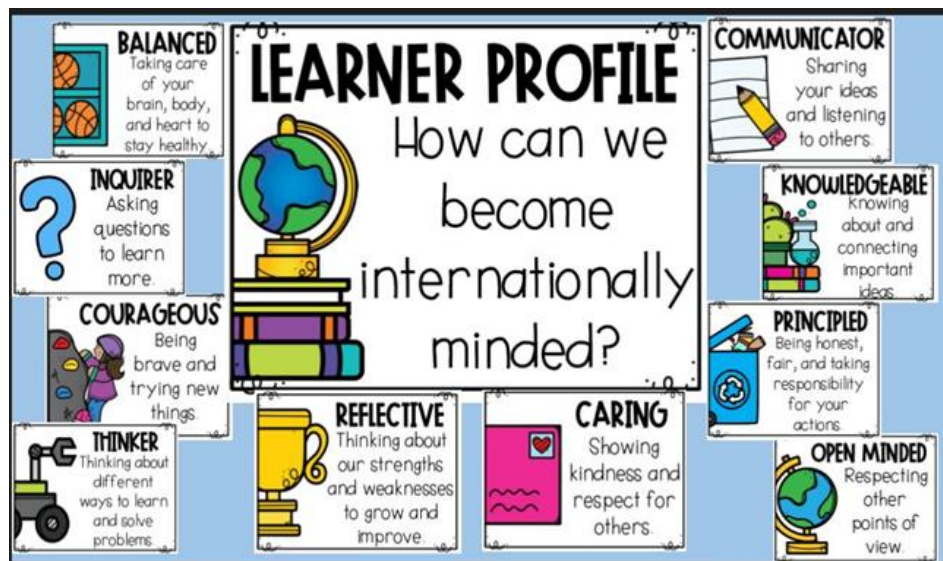

In math, we are working on place value with numbers up to the millions and practicing our multiplication facts. We will be learning about our reading range and setting our AR goals soon.
