



In math, we are working on place value with numbers up to the millions and practicing our multiplication facts. We will be learning about our reading range and setting our AR goals soon. RiverSong Choir:

After several COVID years of not having choir, we are starting up again! I will need you to register your student ahead of time, for planning purposes.** Registration will be open until Friday, September 9, and can be completed online or by having your student request a paper copy of the registration form from Mrs. Flail or in the CLPE office.

There is no fee for choir, but we do ask \$7 for the T-shirt. This can be paid through SchoolPay or by cash/check at school. Anyone unable to pay this fee may request to be loaned a shirt for the performance.

VOLUNTEERS




